He was instrumental in the Corporation's fundraising and establishment of the Marjorie McCune Center Assisted Living Facility for the Blind, Visually Handicapped, and Aged. In addition to his service to WNCL, Bill was a charter member of his lions club, Clyde, was a PDG, recipient of the Melvin Jones Fellowship, a Jack Stickley Fellowship, and is a member of NC Lions Hall of Fame. Jack Stickley Fellowship was created to honor the memory of NC first president of Lions Clubs International. The Fellowship offers progressive recognition with five levels and is available to anyone, lion or non-lion with a monetary contribution as described to the left. All fellowship funds will be placed in an endowment fund with the interest going into the North Carolina Lions Foundation general operating fund. The long-term goal is to acquire enough funds in the Fellowship Endowment for the interest earned to pay the NC Lions Foundation administrative costs. This will permit every dollar raised for NC Lions Foundation to be expended for services to the NC Lions clients. The recipient of the Jack Stickley Fellowship will receive a letter from the North Carolina Lions Foundation President, a Stickley Fellow Pin for each level, and a Personalized Plaque and a numbered Wallet ID Card upon submission of the total \$500.
